Automatic External Defibrillator (AED) Program

An automatic external defibrillator (AED) is a portable device used to induce electrical stimulation to the heart muscle in the event of a potential cardiac arrest. Teachwell has a limited number of AEDs in its facilities. The presence of AEDs in certain locations in selected buildings does not imply that AEDs will generally be available in all locations or in all buildings. Likewise, Teachwell does not make any promise, express or implied, that a trained staff member will be available to operate the AED in the event of a potential cardiac arrest.

Volunteer Responders. Anyone may, at their discretion, provide voluntary assistance to victims of medical emergencies. The extent to which these individuals respond shall be appropriate to their training and experience, and may include CPR, AED or medical first aid.
