

5010 Immunizations

Each student wishing to enroll and participate in person in the programs of Teachwell Solutions must be immunized as required by state law and the rules and regulations promulgated by the South Dakota Department of Health and Human Services within 45 days of the start of classes. The required immunizations are:

- poliomyelitis
- diphtheria
- pertussis
- rubeola
- rubella
- mumps
- tetanus
- meningitis
- varicella

Teachwell Solutions is not responsible for the cost of such immunizations. If a student is unable to afford the proper immunizations, Teachwell Solutions will reach out to the local department of health who will provide the required immunizations at public expense. Any student who does not comply with this policy shall not be permitted to continue attending school.

Exceptions. The student is not required to receive immunizations if the student can provide certification from a licensed physician that immunizations would endanger the student's health or the student's parent or guardian provides a written statement asserting adherence to a religious doctrine opposed to immunization.
