School Calendar/Transportation

Attached/enclosed is the school calendar which indicates the number of days we are in session. You will follow your district's cancellation policy when school is canceled (due to no means of transportation), late start, or early dismissal. Your home district Special Education Director or Transportation Director will coordinate with you regarding transportation to/from Teachwell. Please make sure you contact your district to confirm transportation. Please note, Teachwell's school calendar may be slightly different then your home district calendar. On days in which Teachwell is in session and your home district is not, the student will attend Teachwell. If Teachwell is off and your home district is in session, your student will have those days off. Please review the attached calendar and let Tyler, Katie, PK, or Kristin know if you have any questions.

What to Bring

Prosper Day School does not have a list of mandatory supplies for students. If students prefer a certain type of pencil/pen/markers or other school supplies they may bring those items to be labeled and stored with their school belongings. Other basic school supplies will be provided by the Teachwell Prosper

school. If your student has accidents at times, please send some extra underwear/change of clothes with them in a labeled zip-lock bag that can be stored and accessed when needed. If your student wears briefs/pull-ups, please ensure to send some as well as wipes at the start of the school year. Staff will communicate the need for additional supplies as necessary.

School Lunch

School lunch forms are attached separately for your review. School lunch will be available to purchase. The free or reduced lunch application is also attached. Please note, if you are needing free/reduced lunch, you will need to submit the attached forms prior to the start of the school year. If the forms are not returned prior to the start of the school year and your student orders a lunch it will be billed at full price. We are unfortunately not able to go back and change the price after the meal has been purchased so please return these forms prior to the start of the school year. As always, students may also pack their own lunch/snacks to be stored/prepared at Teachwell as well.

Medications

If your student requires medication that will need to be administered at school you will need to fill out the attached prescription medication forms and return them to Teachwell.

Cell phone use

All students will be given the privilege of accessing their personal phone during non-academic lesson time. However, all parents/students must agree to the cell phone expectation and policy in order for personal phones to be accessed. Please review the attached cell phone policy and sign at the bottom. This document will need to be signed and returned for any student who plans to access a personal cell phone device.

Weather/Dress Attire

Proper attire is to be worn at school by all students to foster an environment conducive to learning. It is important for students to observe basic rules of personal hygiene and dress in a manner that would not disrupt the educational process. With those guidelines, students need to be mindful of the South Dakota seasons too. We understand weather is unpredictable in South Dakota but preparation is key to survival in our lovely state: be prepared for those rainy days, be prepared for those chilly/snowy days, and be prepared for those hot, humid days.

Daily Communication

Each student and their families will be provided with a daily summary of their students day via Seesaw. Daily summaries will include information about behavior, therapies, and other activities they completed throughout their day.
