We are excited for the upcoming school year!


The first day of school is **Wednesday**, **August 20th.** We have included a Teachwell school calendar with this letter. Students will follow the Teachwell calendar regarding holidays and early dismissals.

When should I be there?

Our school day runs from **8:30am-2:45pm.** Thrive staff will greet students at the door on the first day. Students can be dropped off between 8-8:30am and picked up between 2:45-3pm.

How will I get there?

Transportation will be provided by your home school district to and from the Teachwell building, **715 E 14th St**, **Sioux Falls**, **SD**. Your home school district will reach out with transportation schedule information during the month of August. Transportation during the day will be taken care of by Teachwell staff.



Lunch will be available for purchase from the Sioux Falls School District, or you can bring your own lunch. Please avoid sending peanut products due to allergy concerns. On Fridays, we cook as a class, so students will have the option to eat our prepared meal or bring lunch from home. School lunch will not be available to students on Fridays. We will send out additional information on school lunch billing as well as a free and reduced lunch application in mid-August.

What should I bring?

In August and September, you will want to dress comfortably so you are prepared for any outdoor activities we may have. When Project Skills job placements begin in October, we will discuss individual dress code and uniform requirements with students according to employer expectations.

Wait... when will I start working?

We will spend the months of August and September completing career exploration and job interest activities. Students and staff will work together to determine job placements and students will meet and interview with employers prior to starting their internships. Individual start dates may vary, but students typically begin working in the beginning of October.
