

Weapons In Schools

In promoting the well-being of all students and employees, it shall be East Dakota Cooperative's policy to maintain a safe and secure environment in all Cooperative facilities and on Cooperative grounds.

East Dakota Cooperative buildings and property are weapon free zones. Law enforcement will be notified if any person, other than a law enforcement officer, is in possession of

- 1) a firearm, or air gun, whether or not the firearm or air gun is designed, adapted, used, or intended primarily for imitative or noise making purposes; or
- 2) any other object or material that is ordinarily considered a weapon, look-alike weapons, or any object that could place a person in reasonable fear of physical harm.

Searches of students and/or students' personal property for the presence of weapons may be conducted pursuant to Cooperative Board policy and program procedures.

Students found in possession of weapons will receive a consequence as determined by the Cooperative Director.
