

FOOD SERVICES MANAGEMENT

The Cooperative will operate a food service program at the Teachwell Academy/Teachwell Transitions site. The Coop will take part, as feasible, in the National School Lunch Program and other food programs that may become available to see that students at the Academy/Transitions site receive proper nourishment. The Board will annually approve the prices set for school meals.

As required by State and Federal law and regulations, the Cooperative will offer free and reduced price lunches to those qualifying students. The Coop Director and staff serving in the role of Director of Child Nutrition Services will establish procedures that conform with requirements for participation in programs for free and reduced price meals. Such procedures will address the application process for participation in the free and reduced program; processes regarding negative meal account balance and charges; and other procedures deemed necessary to ensure efficient operation and compliance with regulations.
